2007 Wayne State College Baseball Season Outlook

This year's Wayne State College Wildcat baseball team will try to keep the momentum established by the past four clubs, which included four conference championships and three Central Region Tournament appearances. This hard-working, blue-collar bunch is determined to bring home a fifth consecutive Northern Sun Conference championship and return to the NCAA Central Region tournament for the fourth straight year. The 2006 Wildcats return five starters in the field and seven pitchers that logged quality innings last season. Offensively, the Wildcats are expected to hit for good average and with some power. Defensively, WSC lost three of their four starters in the infield. The infield has very good young talent and should improve throughout the season. The pitching staff returns four starters and three relievers. This staff has the ability to be one of the best staffs in school history. In addition to last year's roster, the availability of 2006 redshirts and solid recruits will provide depth to the squad.

Pitching

Leading the staff will be senior left-hander Travis Mortimore. The All-Region selection posted a 9-2 record with a 2.07 ERA with 79 strikeouts in 74.0 innings pitched last season. Joining Mortimore in the rotation are senior right-hander Mike Donohoe and the 2005 NSIC Pitcher of the Year Nick Schumacher. Shoring up relief duties and making some spot starts from the right side will be senior right-hander Nathan Gettler, who posted a team-best 1.59 ERA with 30 strikeouts in 22.2 innings pitched including three saves last season. Other relief duties from the right-side seniors Adam McGuire (led the team with six saves) and Connor Bramlet, junior Mitch Herrick, sophomore Jim Sake and redshirt freshman John Snyder, who is expected to be in the starting rotation when it is all said and done. From the left side, sophomore Nick Esposito will be the only returner from the bullpen. Junior college transfers Ryan Kolo and Kyle Redmond and true freshman Matt Martin and Logan Masters will add more depth to a very deep returning pitching staff.

Mortimore is a big, hard throwing left-hander with an excellent fastball, and an improving curveball and changeup. Andersen is a crafty experienced left-hander with a good fastball and changeup. The All-Region selection will be pitching on the weekends again for the Wildcats. Donohoe has an above average fastball and an outstanding curveball and changeup to match. The hard throwing right-hander will be in the weekend rotation. Snyder is a big, hard throwing right-hander with an excellent fastball and will see time as a starter. Schumacher is an experienced hard throwing right-hander that will be back in the starting rotation after recovering from elbow surgery. Gettler is a tall, lanky right-hander that gives Coach Manganaro the flexibility to start or come out of the bullpen. McGuire, Bramlet, Herrick, Sake and Esposito will bring their experience and competitiveness out of the bullpen and are expected to throw many innings this spring. Newcomer right-handers Kolo, Martin, Masters and Redmond are very talented hard throwing pitchers that are expected to see innings as starters and out of the bullpen. Having an abundance of depth, the 2006 staff has the potential to be one of the best in school history. Coach Manganaro feels assured this staff will be a big part of the 2007 successes, "These pitchers have worked extremely hard preparing for the 2006 season and are in tremendous physical shape. I have no doubt they will give our team an opportunity to win."

Catching

The catching position will be split between senior Jordan Deglan and junior college transfer Jordan Webb. Deglan is a big, strong catcher that receives well and can hit with power. Webb is a hard working catcher that receives well and has a very good arm. Both of them should do a great job behind the plate. Redshirt freshman Darren Kamp will be the backup and has the potential to become a very good hitter. Matt Dunn is a true freshman and will be ready to play if the time arises.

First Base

Junior Marc Manganaro will be the starter at first base this spring. The All-Conference selection hit .353 with 11 doubles, six home runs and 49 RBI's in an impressive sophomore season last year. Sophomore Alex Koch will backup Manganaro this spring. Freshman Matt Martin will also compete for playing time at first base, while freshman Treye Hacker will also be ready to play if the time arises.

Second Base

Two freshman will battle for the starting position at second base. Joe Wendte and Nick Bidroski both show the potential to have very good seasons for the Wildcats as true freshman. Wendte has an explosive bat from the left side, while N. Bidroski has improved defensively and can swing from the left side. Senior Scott Bidroski will back up at second base.

Shortstop

Junior college transfer Brian Sulzman is a sure gloved defensive specialist who will be the backbone of the Wildcat defense in 2007. Backing up Sulzman will be Scott Bidroski.

Third Base

Senior Scott Bidroski will solidify the third base position in 2007. The sure-handed corner guy hit .346 with 14 doubles, seven home runs and 45 RBI's last season for the Wildcats. Koch will back up S. Bidroski.

Outfield

Senior Dustin Jones will patrol center field for the fourth straight season. The All-Region selection hit .393 with six doubles, two home runs, 25 RBI's and stole 23 bases. Scheduled to start in left field is senior Adam Hoffman. Hoffman is a hard-working outfielder that has good speed and range. Sophomore Ian DeLaet won the spot in right field. He had a very impressive freshman season hitting .378 with nine double, four home runs, 23 RBI's and a team-best .640 slugging percentage. Sophomore Sean Soderberg will back up Jones in center field. Soderberg is a speedy outfielder that has also improved at the plate. Wendte and Manganaro will be the back ups at the corner outfield positions. Jereme Johnson has made good improvements through the fall and winter and will help the 'Cats in the future.

Designated Hitter

Sophomore Alex Koch will be the starter at designated hitter for the Wildcats this spring. After transferring in the spring semester last season, Koch hit .338 with 14 doubles, two home runs and 28 RBI's in 42 games at designated hitter. Darren Kamp, Jordan Deglan, Joe Wendte and Matt Martin are very good hitters who possess the potential to hit for power and average which should add fire-power to the offense for the Wildcats in 2007.

Overview

Head Coach John Manganaro is confident this squad possesses the work ethic, tenacity and knowledge of the game to produce a very successful season. The 30-man roster returns 19 players and has 11 newcomers. With the mixture of experience and new talent, the Wildcats should compete for another conference title and regional appearance this spring. "We have a lot of depth and options. We feel we recruited well, filling key spots. The players are coachable, hard working and meshing as a unit. Our pitching staff should be deep enough to keep us in every ballgame. Defensively, we are talented and we possess above average team speed. Our offense is a year older and capable of putting up big numbers. This team is very goal oriented and we are excited for the 2007 season."
