- AWARDS:** Customized **WSC Classic awards** for first place in all events.
- SCORING:** None
- ENTRY LIMITS:** Unlimited
- FACILITY:** 400 meter 8 lane polyurethane track - new in September 2003.
Jumping surfaces are able to be contested either to north or south.
Shot put, discus, and hammer throwing surfaces are cement.
Javelin throwing surface is grass.
- WEIGH-IN:** **Throwing implements will be weighed in beginning at 12:00 pm at the white shed by the shot put sector.**
- WIND:** **All sprint/hurdles/jumps will have wind readings. All sprint/hurdle/jump events will be contested with the wind at the athletes backs to give them the best opportunity to reach optimal performances.**
- SPIKES:** **MAXIMUM LENGTH = ¼" PYRAMID
NO NEEDLE OR CHRISTMAS TREE STYLE SPIKES!**
- BUS PARKING:** Bus drivers will be asked to drop off teams at the track and then park in Lot #10, which is southeast of the track.
- SEEDING:** Please try to be as accurate as possible on entry times.
Your honesty will insure fairness for both your athletes and other teams!
