SPRING 2010 CALENDAR

- October 15, 2009 (Thursday):** Transfer students' acceptance deadline to qualify for Spring 2010 early registration.
- November 16, 2009 (Monday):** WebCat online registration begins at 7:30am for Spring 2010.
- January 6, 2010 (Wednesday):** Application deadline for Residency changes for Spring 2010 tuition purposes.
- January 10 (Sunday):** Residence Halls open at noon.
- January 11 (Monday):** Classes begin at 8:00am.
- January 15, 5pm (Friday):** Last day to register & drop/add; no tuition adjustments and no WebCat drop/add option after today.
- January 18 (Monday):** Payment due for full balance of tuition and fees. Failure to pay may result in late fees, administrative withdrawal from college and/or cancellation of all financial aid. Late enrollment fee in effect - \$15.00.
- January 18 (Monday):** Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (classes will meet).
- January 22 (Friday):** Refund checks available.
- February 12 (Friday):** Last day to select S-NC or audit.
- February 19 (Friday):** Deadline for clearing May Graduation Candidates. Deadline for Incomplete removal from Fall 2009.
- March 1 (Monday):** Summer session registration begins.
- March 8-12 (Monday - Friday):** Mid-term break.
- March 16 (Tuesday):** Mid-term estimates of unsatisfactory grades due in the Office of Records & Registration, 11:55pm.
- March 19 (Friday):** Reports of mid-term unsatisfactory grades to be mailed to students. Assessment Workshop-no afternoon classes after 12:00 noon.
- March 31 (Wednesday):** Last day to withdraw from a class--in person (WebCat option not available). There will be no tuition or fee adjustment. (The last withdrawal date for those classes that do not meet for the entire semester will be one week following the mid-point of the class.)
- April 5 (Monday):** Spring break.
- April 12 (Monday):** Fall 2010 registration begins in the new administrative computing software system.
- April 23 (Friday):** Last day to officially withdraw from school.
- April 27-May 3 (Tuesday - Monday):** Study Week.
- May 4-7 (Tuesday - Friday):** Last class meetings/Final exam week.
- May 8 (Saturday):** Graduate Commencement (9:30am) & Undergraduate Commencement (2pm).

ALL FULL-SEMESTER NIGHT CLASSES

- Monday night classes begin January 11** and will not meet March 8 and April 5. The last class meeting is May 3.
- Tuesday night classes begin January 12** and will not meet March 9. The last class meeting is April 27.
- Wednesday night classes begin January 13** and will not meet March 10. The last class meeting is April 28.
- Thursday night classes begin January 14** and will not meet March 11. The last class meeting is April 29.

SPRING 2010 REGISTRATION BEGINS MONDAY, NOV. 16, 2009

All course offerings in this schedule are contingent upon adequate enrollment. Wayne State College reserves the right to make any changes or deletions in these course offerings. Review of enrollments will occur December 4, 2009. Students and faculty will be notified of changes or course cancellations by December 11, 2009.

IMPORTANT REGULATIONS

Course numbers 100-199 ordinarily are for freshmen or sophomores; courses numbered 200-499 are for sophomores, juniors and seniors; 500-599 are for either senior or post-graduate students; 600-699 are for post-graduate students only; and courses numbered in the 700's are for students in the Education Specialist program. Courses numbered 300 and above are upper level credit. As of Fall 2004 courses numbered 100-499 are assessed undergraduate tuition; courses numbered 500-799 are assessed graduate tuition.

Undergraduates must have the approval of the Registrar to enroll for more than 18 hours. Graduate students must have approval of their Dean to enroll in more than 9 hours.

Students must earn at least 12 hours every two years to retain the privilege of continuing on their present program. Otherwise, they must meet the graduation requirements and academic regulations current at the time they re-enroll.

The new General Education program became effective for the 2008-09 academic year. All incoming undergraduate students now follow the new program. Current students on a prior catalog may choose to move to the new General Education program by requesting to be placed on either the 2008-09 or 2009-10 catalog, but students must also complete any changes applicable to their program of study in that new catalog including major, minor, endorsement, and professional education requirements.

Anyone planning to take courses at another school to apply in a program and qualify for financial aid at Wayne State College, including through the Nebraska State College System Joint Enrollment program, should contact the Office of Records & Registration for [prior approval](#).

WEBCAT ONLINE PROCEDURES TO REGISTER FOR SPRING 2010

1. Undergraduate students will meet with their academic advisor to plan classes for the Spring 2010 semester.
2. After approving class selections, the academic advisors will “release” students to register on the Web. **Students will need academic advisor approval in order to access their registration screen.**
3. Students can find WebCat on the WSC home page and will log in using their campus-wide ID (or SS#) and PIN number (students who lost or forgot PIN numbers – please go to the Records and Registration Office in Hahn with a picture ID for assistance).
4. New students need to contact the Admissions Office for application, registration, and PIN information. Former students need to call or to stop with a picture ID at the Records and Registration Office to get a PIN assigned. That number is 402-375-7239.
5. After signing on to WebCat, follow registration instructions on the screen. Call numbers printed in the class schedule booklet are required in the online data entry process. A registration hold will prevent online registration.
6. Registration will begin by student classification on Monday, November 16, 2009 and will remain open through 5pm Friday, January 15, 2010. **Classification is based on hours earned at the start of the Fall 2009 semester.**

WebCat registration is usually available Mondays-Saturdays from 7:30am-2:00am the following morning and on Sundays from 1:00pm-2:00am the following morning. It is recommended that students consult with their academic advisors prior to dropping and adding classes.

7. Athletes must have the Compliance Officer's signature to drop/add.
8. Please Note: Closed classes, directed studies, special projects, independent studies and courses requiring approval will need to be recorded on paper forms and submitted to the Records and Registration Office.
9. Continuing Education students who cannot access their WebCat screens should call the Continuing Education Office for assistance at 402-375-7217.
10. Graduate students may register without advisor approval but those in a graduate program should consult with their graduate advisor before registering for classes.

**Important Information - Final grades must be accessed from your WebCat screens.
Grade slips are no longer mailed to students at the end of the semester.**

BUSINESS SERVICES OFFICE INFORMATION

Account statements are no longer mailed. Students may access account balance information on-line via WebCat. Charges will be based upon current registration information and updated daily. Charges including tuition, fees, room, meal plans, and all other fees that may be assessed are due on or before the sixth day of the term, January 18, 2010. Any charges to the student's account after the sixth day of the term are due immediately. Accounts not paid in full by the sixth day of the term may be subject to non-payment fees and/or withdrawal from classes for non-payment.

Students with a balance due after financial aid (including student loans) and scholarships have been deducted must pay the balance due by the sixth day of the term or non-payment fees may apply as well as possible withdrawal for non-payment.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If the WSC Financial Aid Office has not received your required paperwork early enough to complete your financial aid award (tuition waiver, Pell, SEOG, SSAP, Stafford, Perkins, Foundation scholarship, room or board waiver, employee or dependent tuition waiver), you must be prepared to pay the balance due from other means by the due date. Students with changes in enrollment status or amount of expected aid must notify the Financial Aid Office immediately. Recalculation, as a result of such changes, may cause a delay in the release of financial aid funds.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Students with financial aid in excess of total charges will be issued a refund check. These checks will be available in the Business Services Office on Friday, January 22, 2010. However, checks will not be released until all account holds (parking violation, library fine, etc.) have been cleared.

Enrollment for the semester is considered complete only after check payment for charges has cleared the bank. When paying by check, you expressly authorize Wayne State College, if your check is dishonored or returned for any reason, to electronically debit your account for the amount of the check plus a processing fee (\$35) not to exceed the state maximum legal limit (plus any applicable sales tax). The use of a check for payment is your acknowledgement of this policy and its terms.

TUITION & FEE ADJUSTMENTS AND SCHEDULE CHANGES

Tuition and fees will be adjusted for changes made through Friday, January 15, 2010. After that date, there will be no adjustment in tuition or fees, or any refund if a class is dropped.

THIRD PARTY BILLING AUTHORIZATION

If you wish to authorize the Wayne State College Business Services Office to release and discuss your student account information with anyone other than yourself you will need to complete the Billing Authorization section of the Wayne State College Payment Authorization form. Note: This may include but is not limited to your parents, legal guardians, and/or any third party making payments on your behalf.

National Guard members who wish to receive military tuition assistance must submit their class schedule to their unit by the unit deadline, provide appropriate verification of enrollment by the start of the semester, & must complete the online DA Form 2171E-R. Grades from the previous semester must be on file in the National Guard Tuition Assistance Office before a new tuition assistance application is approved. Repeated classes will not be approved for tuition assistance.

Members of the Army Reserve must submit their tuition credit application to the Financial Aid Office as soon as it is received from their commanding officer, but by the start of the semester

Veterans: Remember that if you drop or withdraw from a class which brings your class load below the required full-time level, three-quarter level, etc. or if you withdraw from school without extenuating circumstances, your benefits will

be adjusted or terminated retroactively to the beginning of the semester instead of from the date of withdrawal. You will be required to reimburse the VA for payments received.

ROOM & BOARD ADJUSTMENTS

Changes/Additions to room & board for students in a residence hall should be made with the Residence Life Office. Changes/Additions to board for commuter students should be made with Business Services. All changes must be made no later than Friday, January 15, 2010.

PAYMENT PLAN

FACTS is a tuition management plan that offers a low cost option for budgeting tuition and other educational expenses. The plan requires a \$25.00 per semester non-refundable enrollment fee.

Automatic Bank Payment (ACH) will be used to make your monthly payment(s) from a checking, savings or credit card account (MasterCard or Discover). All monthly payments will be processed on the 5th of each month.

The Business Services Office may adjust your plan balance if your account balance or financial aid package change. All adjustments will be made on the 20th of each month.

COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL

Students will receive a prorated adjustment for Room & Board which is charged through the last day of the week in which the student properly checks out of the dorm after withdrawal. Tuition and Fees adjustments for withdrawal from school will be determined by the Business Services Office based on the schedule below. THERE WILL BE NO TUITION & FEE ADJUSTMENT BECAUSE OF REDUCTION IN LOAD AFTER THE LAST DAY TO DROP/ADD.

PARKING PERMITS

Parking permits may be purchased at the Business Services Office. Full year permits are valid from the first day of the Fall semester up to the first day of the subsequent Fall semester. Spring semester only permits are available at a reduced rate. Vehicles parked on campus without a valid permit will be ticketed. Parking regulations are in effect 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

STUDY WEEK/FINAL EXAM POLICY

The following study week guidelines regarding exams and class projects shall be observed by faculty and students, as approved by the Faculty Senate on 8/27/93:

1. Final examinations for semester classes are to be given only on a day designated during final exam week as published in this schedule.
2. Only make-up or laboratory/practical examinations may be given during study week.

3. Only those projects, papers, speeches, and other assignments that were delineated in the course outline or given in writing by the end of the eighth week of the semester may be scheduled for completion during study week.

Student requests to take final examinations prior to the regularly scheduled time must be approved by the Dean/Department Chair.

SPRING 2010 FINAL EXAMINATION SCHEDULE

TO: All Wayne State College Students

RE: Drug Free Schools and Campuses Act

In compliance with the Department of Education's (34 CFR Part 86) requirements you are hereby notified of the expected standards of conduct regarding the unlawful use of drugs or alcohol on college property or in any college sponsored activity. In addition, this document will describe legal sanctions (local, state and Federal), health risks, available assistance and treatment avenues as well as college imposed disciplinary measures.

1. Standards of Conduct: The following are deemed to be misconduct and subject to disciplinary action.
 - A. Alcohol Use - The illegal possession or illegal consumption of alcoholic beverages on college owned or controlled property, or at college sponsored or supervised events.
 - B. Drug Use - Possessing, distributing, using, or selling illegal drugs or any other controlled substance or agent having the potential of abuse, except pursuant to a physician's or dentist's prescription, or possessing paraphernalia for drug use on college owned or controlled property or at university sponsored or supervised events.
2. Students are subject to all applicable legal sanctions under local, state and Federal law regarding unlawful possession or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol. These sanctions may include incarceration and/or fines for those found guilty under these sanctions.
3. The health risks of using illegal drugs and the use of alcohol are difficult to predict due to the unknown chemicals involved in these substances. These health risks may be severe and lead to permanent impairment or even death. Even occasional use or experimentation can have significant negative consequences. The diminishment of intellectual ability, personality disintegration and long term genetic damage are not uncommon occurrences among drug and alcohol abusers.
4. Assistance is available through the Counseling Center (located in the Student Center), the Student Health Center (located in the Student Center), or any of the area community agencies, or private treatment centers for students seeking help for problems associated with illegal drug and alcohol use.
5. The College will impose disciplinary sanctions on students for violation of the student conduct code relating to alcohol or drug use. Consult the current Student Handbook.

It should be emphasized that when a student's violation of the law also adversely affects the College's pursuit of its recognized educational objectives, the College may enforce its own regulations regardless of any civil proceeding or dispositions. When students violate a college regulation they are subject to disciplinary action by the College whether or not their conduct violated civil law. If a student's behavior simultaneously violated a college regulation and the civil law, the College may take disciplinary action independent of that taken by civil authorities. When students violate laws off campus, they may incur penalties described by civil authorities. College discipline will be initiated for instances of student misconduct off campus which distinctly and adversely affect the college's pursuit of its recognized educational purposes.

Disciplinary measures appropriate to the offense up to and including dismissal from the College may be imposed.

Student Right-to-Know

Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act, Public Law 101-542, requires that institutions of higher education provide information on their graduation rates to currently enrolled and prospective students. Wayne State College graduation rates are available through the office of the Vice President for Student Affairs.

Privacy Act

The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act protects the student's right to privacy. The law does allow the institution to share, without written permission of the student, "directory information." At Wayne State College that information consists of the following: (a) name, address (including e-mail), and telephone number; (b) date and place of birth; (c) major field of study; (d) participation in officially recognized activities and sports; (e) weight and height of members of athletic teams; (f) dates of attendance; (g) degrees and awards received; (h) most recent previous educational institution attended; (i) full/part time enrollment; (j) and year in college. Any Wayne State student who wishes to have directory information protected must complete a special form supplied by the Office of Records and Registration, Hahn 105. This form must be completed and returned to the Office of Records and Registration within ten (10) days following the publication of the privacy announcement in the college newspaper each fall to prevent name and address information from appearing in the campus directory.
