## SUMMER REGISTRATION BEGINS MONDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 7:30am for ALL STUDENTS

It is very important that everyone planning to attend any of the summer sessions register as soon as possible; registration is open through the second day of each session.

**Wayne State College reserves the right to cancel classes with enrollment below established minimums. If the college determines the class is to be cancelled, students registered in the class will be notified at least one week prior to the first day of that class.**

## IMPORTANT REGULATIONS

Students may register for a maximum of 18 hours during the summer term, usually limited to four hours in the 3-Week Session, seven hours in each 5-Week Session, or nine hours in the 8-Week Session, except with approval of the Registrar for undergraduates or the appropriate Dean for graduate students. Contact the Records & Registration Office – 1-800-228-9972 Ext. 7239 or Continuing Education Office – 1-800-228-9972 Ext. 7217 for assistance.

Students must earn at least 12 hours every two years to retain the privilege of continuing on their present program. Students who fail to earn 12 hours in any two-year period will have to meet the graduation requirements and academic regulations current at the time they re-enroll.

Courses numbered 100-199 ordinarily are for freshmen or sophomores; courses numbered 200-499 are for sophomores, juniors and seniors; 500-599 for either seniors or graduate students; and 600-699 for graduate students only. 700-level courses are primarily for students enrolled in the Education Specialist degree program; however, graduate students may be admitted with the permission of the advisor and the Dean of the School of Education & Counseling. Tuition charges changed in fall 2004. Students now pay tuition based on the course level rather than the student classification. Courses numbered 100-499 are assessed undergraduate tuition; courses numbered 500-799 are assessed graduate tuition.

Anyone planning to take courses at another school to apply to a program at Wayne State College should contact the Office of Records & Registration for the proper procedure for prior approval.

Enrollment certification for **veteran's benefits** requires verification by individual summer session. For this purpose only, full-time enrollment for each session is as follows: 3-week session - 2 hrs; 5-week session - 4 hrs; 8-week session – 6 hrs; 13-week session – 9 hrs.

## WildcatsOnline - PROCEDURES TO REGISTER

WSC Students register on the Web.

1. New undergraduate and graduate students need to contact the Admissions Office for application and registration. Former students who need to provide updated information should call or stop at the Records and Registration Office. That number is (402)375-7239 with temporary location during 2011-12 in room 154 in the Student Center.
2. Undergraduate students will meet with their academic advisor to plan classes for the summer sessions.
3. Students should log into eCampus, then click on Online Resources> WildcatsOnline. If you have problems logging into WildcatsOnline or eCampus, please contact the Network and Technology Services Helpdesk at (402)375-7107 or e-mail [helpdesk@wsc.edu](mailto:helpdesk@wsc.edu).
4. **Registration will begin on Monday, February 27 at 7:30am for ALL STUDENTS. Registration will remain open through the end of the second day of each session.**

**WildcatsOnline drop/add option is usually available at all times except when the entire system will be unavailable due to maintenance Monday and Thursday mornings from 1:00am to 5:00am and the third Sunday of every month from 6:00am until noon.**

5. Once a student has registered, he/she is free to drop/add until the end of the second day of classes for each session. It is recommended that students consult with their academic advisors prior to dropping and adding classes.
6. Please Note: Closed classes, directed studies, special projects, independent studies and courses requiring approval will need to be recorded on paper forms and submitted to the Records and Registration Office, SC 154.
7. Continuing Education students who cannot access their WildcatsOnline screens should call the Continuing Education Office for assistance at (402)375-7217.
8. All official campus communication is by WSC e-mail.

**Important Final Grade Information** – Final grades must be accessed from your WildcatsOnline screens. Grade slips are not mailed to students.

**Important Student Record Information** – “Guest Access” to different modules in WildcatsOnline can be granted by students to as many as five different people as a way to share financial and academic information with parents, guardians, spouses, or anyone the student deems as needing this information. **TUITION & FEES BY SUMMER SESSION ARE DUE on or before May 8, June 5, and July 10.** Please contact the Business Services Office at (402) 375-7225 for questions relating to tuition & fees. To sign up for the monthly payment plan, go to [ecampus.wsc.edu](http://ecampus.wsc.edu), select Online Resources and then e-Cashier.

A Matriculation Fee of \$10.00 will be assessed to all first-time students.

**Parking Permits purchased for any of the summer sessions are \$13.00.** All permits are valid until the start of the Fall 2012 term.

**You may access your account information and pay your balance with a debit/credit card or e-check via WildcatsOnline at [ecampus.wsc.edu](http://ecampus.wsc.edu).**

**Enrollment is considered complete only after checks for payment of charges have cleared the bank.** When you pay by check, you authorize Wayne State College, if your check is dishonored or returned for any reason, to electronically debit your account for the amount of the check plus a processing fee not to exceed the state maximum legal limit. The use of a check for payment is your acknowledgement of this policy and its terms.

## COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL

Tuition and Fee adjustments for withdrawal from school will be determined by the Business Services Office based on the schedule below. THERE WILL BE NO TUITION & FEE ADJUSTMENT BECAUSE OF REDUCTION IN LOAD AFTER THE LAST DAY TO DROP/ADD.

1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Days.....100%  
3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Days.....50%  
After 4<sup>th</sup> Day.....none

**NOTE: Financial aid may need to be reduced for complete withdrawal from school or reduction in academic load.**

## FINANCIAL AID

**Federal Financial aid** policy requires enrollment in a minimum of twelve total credit hours of summer school coursework to be considered full-time. Please contact the Financial Aid Office for summer financial aid information and requirements.

Summer school students needing a **student loan deferment** must be enrolled at least half-time (unless the loan agreement specifically requires full-time attendance). For deferment purposes half-time for students in undergraduate programs is six (6) credit hours over the course of the summer. For students enrolled in graduate programs it is five (5) credit hours.

**TO: All Wayne State College Students**

**RE: Drug Free Schools and Campuses Act**

In compliance with the Department of Education's (34 CFR Part 86) requirements you are hereby notified of the expected standards of conduct regarding the unlawful use of drugs or alcohol on college property or in any college sponsored activity. In addition, this document will describe legal sanctions (local, state and Federal), health risks, available assistance and treatment avenues as well as college imposed disciplinary measures.

1. Standards of Conduct: The following are deemed to be misconduct and subject to disciplinary action.
  - A. Alcohol Use - The illegal possession or illegal consumption of alcoholic beverages on college owned or controlled property, or at college sponsored or supervised events.
  - B. Drug Use - Possessing, distributing, using, or selling illegal drugs or any other controlled substance or agent having the potential of abuse, except pursuant to a physician's or dentist's prescription, or possessing paraphernalia for drug use on college owned or controlled property or at university sponsored or supervised events.
2. Students are subject to all applicable legal sanctions under local, state and Federal law regarding unlawful possession or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol. These sanctions may include incarceration and/or fines for those found guilty under these sanctions.
3. The health risks of using illegal drugs and the use of alcohol are difficult to predict due to the unknown chemicals involved in these substances. These health risks may be severe and lead to permanent impairment or even death. Even occasional use or experimentation can have significant negative consequences. The diminishment of intellectual ability, personality disintegration and long term genetic damage are not uncommon occurrences among drug and alcohol abusers.
4. Assistance is available through the Counseling Center (located in the Student Center), the Student Health Center (located in the Student Center), or any of the area community agencies, or private treatment centers for students seeking help for problems associated with illegal drug and alcohol use.
5. The College will impose disciplinary sanctions on students for violation of the student conduct code relating to alcohol or drug use. Consult the current Student Handbook.

It should be emphasized that when a student's violation of the law also adversely affects the College's pursuit of its recognized educational objectives, the College may enforce its own regulations regardless of any civil proceeding or dispositions. When students violate a college regulation they are subject to disciplinary action by the College whether or not their conduct violated civil law. If a student's behavior simultaneously violated a college regulation and the civil law, the College may take disciplinary action independent of that taken by civil authorities. When students violate laws off campus, they may incur penalties described by civil authorities. College discipline will be initiated for instances of student misconduct off campus which distinctly and adversely affect the college's pursuit of its recognized educational purposes.

Disciplinary measures appropriate to the offense up to and including dismissal from the College may be imposed.

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### **Student Right-to-Know**

Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act, Public Law 101-542, requires that institutions of higher education provide information on their graduation rates to currently enrolled and prospective students. Wayne State College graduation rates are available through the office of the Vice President for Student Affairs.

### **Privacy Act**

The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act protects the student's right to privacy. The law does allow the institution to share, without written permission of the student, "directory information." At Wayne State College that information consists of the following: 1) Student's name; 2) Permanent address (limited to the identification of city, state & country); 3) Participation in officially recognized activities and sports; 4) Weight/height of members of athletic teams; 5) Degrees, honors and awards received; 6) Major field of study; 7) Dates of attendance (only the beginning and end dates of the semester); 8) Year in school; 9) Enrollment status (full/part-time); 10) The most recent previous educational agency or institution attended. Any Wayne State student who wishes to have directory information protected can do so through their WildcatsOnline student center or by submitting written notification to the Office of Records and Registration.
