Red Road training is being sponsored by the Ponca Tribe in Norfolk, NE. Kathy will send the information via email.

Policy and Enforcement:

The Wayne Police Department and the Wayne County Sheriff's Office conducted compliance checks at all licensed liquor establishments in Wayne County. 26% were found to be non-compliant, meaning they sold alcohol to an underage person. Five establishments in Wayne and one in Wakefield are having violations filed and five employees are being charged with sale of alcohol to a minor.

Project Extra Mile (PEM): Steve Shear outlined the proposed diversion program for Wayne County. Parental involvement will be required. It is modeled after the Cuming County program. Jill Belt, LMHP, of Providence Medical Center will case manage the program.

Wildcat Wheels Safe Ride Program: The program is hiring dispatchers for the fall semester. Key tags are being ordered instead of mouse pads this year.
