Examples that would be in the posters are "WSC students taking advantage of another sexually decreased from 4.3% in 2006 to 1.6% in 2009" and "The number of WSC students who had been taken advantage of sexually decreased from 13.7% in 2006 to 8.4% in 2009." The poster campaign will be implemented during the Fall 2010 semester.
