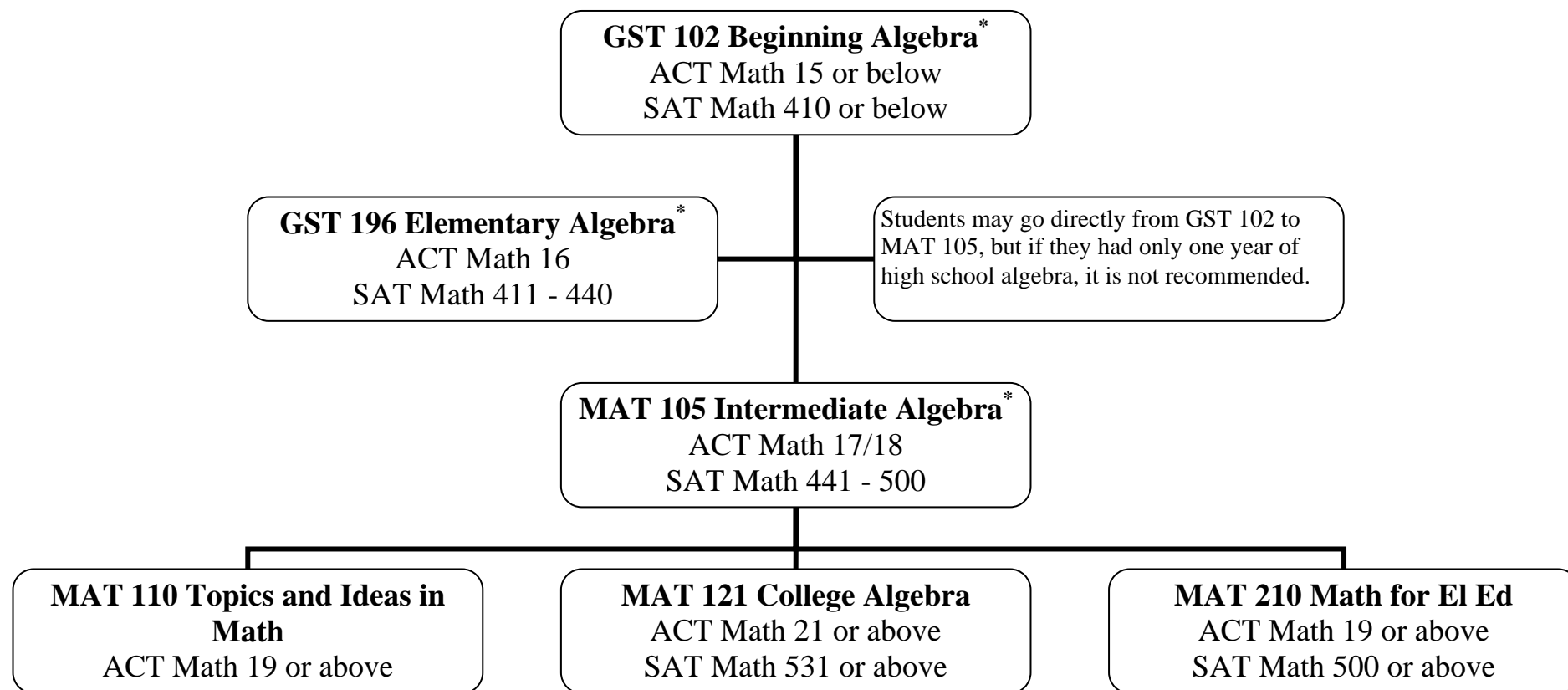


Wayne State College MATHEMATICS PLACEMENT POLICY

In an effort to address student success in math courses, beginning in the Fall of 2007 students new to Wayne State College are placed in the appropriate mathematics course based on their ACT Math scores. As a result, students may need to take additional courses to meet their mathematics requirement. Regardless of recommended placement, students will not be required to take any course above what is required for their major.

If a student does not have an ACT Math score, or wishes to challenge their placement in a course, they may take the COMPASS placement exam. This self-paced exam is taken on the computer and takes about fifteen to twenty minutes to complete. Based on the student's responses to questions, the program gives either an easier or more difficult question. Scores on this exam are then used to place the student in the appropriate course.
