

RHOP Selection Guidelines

Numerous factors are always a part of the selection process; however, special emphasis is placed on:

1. The academic potential of the student as demonstrated by:
 - a. G.P.A.
 - b. Letters of Recommendation
 - c. ACT/SAT scores
2. A commitment to return to the rural areas of Nebraska to practice their profession, including:
 - a. Knowledge of the profession
 - b. Community service and leadership activities
3. Academic preparation: Students are strongly encouraged to have completed or plan to complete the following core courses (if possible) to demonstrate their academic preparation:
 - ▶ Three years of Math
 - ▶ Four years of English
 - ▶ One year each of Biology, Chemistry and Physics
4. A biography of why the student wants to be in RHOP, as this becomes the foundation for the interview/selection process.

We are looking for a well-rounded student who is dedicated to the health profession and has a demonstrated commitment to the rural areas of Nebraska. One who is willing to work hard and has demonstrated they have the intellectual ability to complete the rigorous academic programs of the health professions at WSC and UNMC.
