Through this program, you'll obtain your bachelor's degree in the field of your choice at Wayne State, then take one year of classes to receive your nursing degree (BSN) through UNMC. Suggested programs of study are available for applied human and sport physiology, biology, communication studies, psychology and sociology, and Spanish. Whether you are a current student at Wayne State, transferring from another school, or even a current employee of a nursing home or hospital, this is a great opportunity to pair your current skills and interests with an education in health care, leading to a fulfilling and lasting career.

### Get your B.A. or B.S. in any major at Wayne State College.

You'll complete a bachelor's degree in any major at WSC while also completing preparatory BSN. curriculum. Upon prospective graduation from WSC, you'll apply to the accelerated nursing program at UNMC's Norfolk campus.

### Get your BSN in one year through UNMC.

The UNMC accelerated nursing program runs from January to December.

### Guaranteed admission eligibility:

You may be eligible for guaranteed slots based on UNMC College of Nursing honors admission criteria:

- 3.8 GPA in prerequisite coursework
- No repeated courses
- No pass/fail in science courses
- No grade below C+ in any course
