The four-year plan is provided as a suggestion. Final decisions rest with the student and advisor based on availability of courses. Summer courses are not included in this plan but may be an option. This should be discussed between the student and advisor.

#### WSC Requirements:

The CAT 5 requirement may be filled by either PSY 101 or SOC 101; however, both courses are required for this nursing program track. To graduate, students must pass 120 total credit hours of which 40 hours must be upper level (300 or above) and a 2.75 cumulative GPA.

#### UNMC Requirements:

Students must earn at least a C+ or better and must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA for prerequisite courses (above 3.3 recommended).

# Students must complete these courses within seven years of applying to UNMC Accelerated Nursing Program.
