HONORED RETIRING FACULTY

The Red and Gold cord is worn by members of Sigma Delta Pi, a Hispanic honor society.

The Maroon and White cord is worn by members of Upsilon Pi Epsilon, an International Honor Society for Computing and Information Disciplines.

The Royal Blue cord is worn by members of Tau Upsilon Alpha, a national organization of human services honorary.

The double Dark Green and Gold cord is worn by members of the Honors Program. These students graduate with high honors, honors or scholar in their majors.

The Gold stole is worn by members of the Philomathean President's Honorary Society.
