Mr. Byron Schafersman, Alumni Achievement Award

Byron Schafersman is the recipient of the Wayne State Foundation's Alumni Achievement Award, which is presented to a graduate who has attained outstanding achievement in his or her career and/or through community service and has provided support to WSC. The Alumni Achievement Award is given at the May and November commencement exercises.

Schafersman graduated from Wayne State College in 2004 with a bachelor's degree in Speech Communication. He is an entrepreneur who has created a business portfolio with a footprint spanning the upper-Midwest that includes real-estate development, beverage distribution, technology, software, finance, and aviation.

A Hooper, Neb., native, Schafersman is the son of Mark and Jean Schafersman. He lives in Dell Rapids, S.D., with his wife of 11 years, Amber, also a 2004 graduate of WSC. The The John G. Neihardt Scholars Program provides special academic and scholarship opportunities for outstanding students enrolling at Wayne State College.

Each year the Scholarship Council selects a limited number from the qualified applicants to participate in the program, which offers special classes, colloquia, and advisement.

Students accepted into the program, who maintain their eligibility, are awarded a four-year scholarship for tuition up to 128 total credit hours, eight semesters of room waiver, and an annual stipend of \$500.
