Instructions:

Students can appeal the loss of Federal and State Aid (grants, work study, student loans, parent loans) if there are unusual circumstances, such as a serious illness, death in the family, or other factors that impacted their academic performance.

Appeals **must be submitted within 30 days** of the date of your Financial Aid Suspension notification.

To appeal, submit the following:

- Completed Appeal Form
- Personal statement answering the following questions:
 - Why was meeting the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy standards a challenge for you?
 - What has changed that will allow you to meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy standards at the end of the next evaluation period*? *SAP is evaluated at the end of each semester.
- Third-party supporting documentation (if available), such as:
 - Doctor's note or medical records
 - Court/legal documents
 - Obituary or death certificate
 - Any other relevant documentation
