## Curriculum and Instruction - Instructional Leadership

Enhance your teaching, leadership, and instructional skills for early childhood education. In the Curriculum and Instruction MSE program, you will explore instructional theory and contemporary approaches to curriculum design that support effective teaching and learning. The Early Childhood Education emphasis focuses on the growth and development of young children from birth through age eight, developmentally appropriate curriculum and assessment, and the leadership and management of early childhood programs.

This program is designed for educators who are already certified in early childhood education and wish to deepen their expertise while earning a master's degree; it does not lead to initial teacher certification, and licensure requirements may vary by state.
