This program builds IT management and business skills, needed to evaluate, plan, deploy, manage, and supervise the operational, tactical, and strategic use of technology within an organization. Coursework covers key areas such as project management; managing technology within organizations; and the theory, design, and implementation of computer and communication systems. Graduates are prepared for advanced roles such as chief information officers, network architects, computer systems administrators, and IT analysts.
