Certificate of Advanced Studies

The Addictions Counseling certificate is designed for counselors and graduate students seeking specialized preparation for working with substance abuse and addictive disorders. Addictions counselors assess client needs and develop individualized treatment plans, and this certificate strengthens the clinical skills needed to do so effectively. The courses for the Addictions Counseling certificate at Wayne State College are aimed at providing education typically needed in addition to a graduate counseling degree for application toward Nebraska state licensure for drug and alcohol counseling. Coursework emphasizes alcohol and drug assessment, level of care placement, treatment planning, case management, documentation, ethical practice, and evidence-informed counseling approaches for diverse populations. Students and professionals may pursue this certificate if they are completing coursework in a graduate counseling program or related field, or have completed a graduate degree in counseling or a related field.
