

# TRAUMA COUNSELING GRADUATE CERTIFICATE

## Certificate of Advanced Studies

The Trauma Counseling certificate is designed for graduate counseling students and professionals who want specialized preparation for working with clients impacted by trauma. Topics addressed are expected to include professional self-awareness, evidence-based interventions and application, and the integration of physiological responses in mental health treatment. Coursework also explores advanced clinical considerations such as trauma across the lifespan, complex trauma, and the ways trauma symptoms can affect relationships, behavior, and overall wellbeing. Students may pursue this coursework if they have been accepted and are completing coursework in a graduate counseling program or related field. Professionals who are seeking this certificate are eligible if they have completed a graduate degree in counseling or a related field and are in good standing with all state licensure boards and national certification bodies.
